Mr N J Burden BVSc CertVOphthal MRCVS will offer eye testing under the BVA/KC/ISDS Eye Scheme at the above Show. The results will be reported confidentially to the owner and a BVA/KC/ISDS Certificate of Examination provided, the Kennel Club Registration Certificate will be stamped accordingly.

Please ensure that you have the Registration Certificate with you.

It would also be helpful if owners could bring any previous Eye Certificates.

In addition to discovering whether your Cairn has any eye problem, it is important to have a re-examination if;

- It has ever had any eye disorder
- It is a relative of a Cairn known to have any eye disease
- It is an older Cairn who may have developed a problem since it was last tested.
- **Please note that gonioscopy will not be performed**

Some eye defects do not become apparent until the Cairn is older.

The Cairn Terrier Health Group will subsidise the cost of the examination.

The cost to owners will therefore be only **£13** per dog whereas a private examination would cost about £29. (A minimum of 25 dogs is required for this special rate)

Eye drops will be used but these do not cause the dog any discomfort.

Dogs undergoing examination need not be entered at the show as The Kennel Club has given permission for them to attend.

Other breeds will also be welcome, the cost for them will be £29.

Please note all dogs must now be micro-chipped before eye testing can take place. Your dog can be micro-chipped on the day by the vet for a fee of £16.99 per dog. This must also be pre-booked.
